

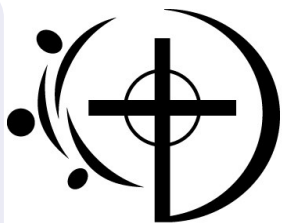

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today the Church universal celebrates the great outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Our Pentecost celebration is often referred to as the birthday of the Church. In years gone by I have always equated Pentecost with something different than a birthday. It always represented the entrance into the last few weeks of school. Somehow my memory recalls only the sunny and warm Pentecost days - the beautiful smells of new life, the light of day that lingers longer, the joy of the seeding complete. I am sure in my life there have been many Pentecost days that we experienced rain and grey skies. I have chosen to forget those days.

This year the Pentecost celebration has taken on new life as my garden reveals life and colour. The Campfire roses in their beautiful yellow and red hues have bloomed and, like their name, they represent a living fire of spirit, of flesh and of love. Pentecost always has been and always will be about the living. A resurrected Spirit of love flowing from the heart of the Son that fills us with the same desire to bring forth the will of God. Like embers that catch fire, this Spirit glows with a renewed sense of purpose waiting to ignite the hearts of the believers.

Often times I hear people saying: "I don't really feel the Spirit within me." This mysterious reality of the Spirit of Jesus within us can be a difficult thing to comprehend. It is not uncommon that for the believers, the one person of the Holy Trinity that they struggle most with is the Holy Spirit. But fear of the Spirit must never be a part of our faith journey. Regardless of our understanding of such a mystery we are called to place ourselves in the midst of the mystery, to open ourselves to the wonderful nature of the three-fold God. The Spirit needs a receptive and living vessel and no one is more qualified for that than you and I.

And so on this glorious Pentecost Sunday we make our pledge to open ourselves completely to the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. We do not shy away from it but rather expose our hearts and souls that God will ignite us with the love of the Son to be the living witnesses and disciples of the Resurrection. Open your hearts that the Spirit may enter. It is then that the fullness of life will be revealed to you.

Come Holy Spirit and fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in us the fire of your Divine Love. And help me Holy Spirit, to recognize that I am one of the faithful.

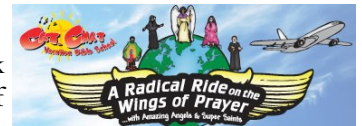

It is hoped that this prayerbook will be used by clergy and laypeople in numerous church contexts and for personal devotions. The plan is to charge nothing for the book, but to distribute it freely. Those receiving books will be invited to make a donation to a local ecumenical project. To facilitate this, the diocese of Saskatoon must raise the full cost of publishing the book.
