



## STEWARDS OF A GREATER HOPE

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

These past number of weeks we have had the opportunity to enter into a renewed spirit of what it means to be stewards of God's gifts. Our Gospel passages have revealed an inner beauty of giving and sharing - making God's Kingdom on Earth a living reality.

As stewards we have the responsibility of caring for what God has created, of sharing the many blessings that God has bestowed upon us, of thanking God for his many acts of kindness and of sharing our treasures for the sake of a greater hope.

There are times that we might shy away from speaking about finances, hoping that such financial situations will take care of themselves. I know of no priest that enjoys standing before his people and asking for money and many a priest has prayed fervently that the balance sheet will work itself out on its own. But this attitude is exactly what stewardship is not. Stewardship is not shying away from the reality but speaking directly to the reality.

One of the greatest blessings in my life has been to journey with all of you through the process of the design and construction of this beautiful facility. It was an incredible stretch on the part of our people. Generous hearts and minds ruled the day and immeasurable prayer sustained our efforts. We trusted in God and believed in each other and as a result in six weeks time we will celebrate our third anniversary in this building. This anniversary will happen because of you; your trust in the mission, your belief in God's guidance and your conviction of a greater hope. There is little doubt that my heart explodes with pride when I think of you. So many said we would never make this happen, and yet, our faithful God prevailed. You were given a task, you were asked to financially stretch yourselves and you accomplished all of this. The Cathedral of the Holy Family stands as a testimony to your faith.

This weekend I speak of the on-going stewardship of our parish. This year we began the colossal task of paying off the mortgage. In doing so we direct approximately \$14,000 per month to the cause. As such, we can find it difficult to cover the expenses and we dream of the day when that monthly payment will be no more. But it is a payment that is necessary. We have been blessed with interest rates that are manageable and doubly blessed by generous people. Even though we carry the burden of debt it has not prevented us from reaching out in wonderful ways and accomplishing ministry that we never thought possible. Even with monthly payments we have forged ahead with a life-changing relationship with the Friendship Inn, we have been blessed with missionary activity to Haiti, monies that allow us to offer faith development programs and the ever-needed sacramental preparation for those seeking Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage.

This mission and ministry has strengthened us as a community. We are Holy Family . . . and we are so because of you.

When all of us do a little we can accomplish a lot. That is why today I ask that you give consideration to raising your level of financial giving. We know that if every person gave just 10% more then our operational deficit would be greatly reduce—perhaps even erased. And that is why today I ask that you consider a 10% increase. I know for some this might not be possible and I thank you for the level that you are giving. But I also know that in asking, because it is needed, your response will be positive. It always has been. And it is why with my deepest gratitude and appreciation I thank you for being Stewards of a Greater Hope.
