

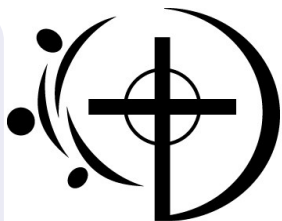

We are Holy Family

11th Sunday in Ordinary Time - June 14th, 2015

Dear parishioners and staff of Holy Family,

I would like to take this opportunity to offer heartfelt thanks for a wonderful two years here at Holy Family. I remember when I first arrived, a bit nervous but mostly excited to dive into parish ministry, and being struck by the strong sense of community that exists here. I noticed that people stuck around after mass to visit and socialize and I thought to myself "this is a good sign." It was kind of like first moving into the rectory, not knowing what to expect and not really knowing Fr. David, and then seeing his Montreal Canadian's blanket on the couch. This was a totally unexpected consolation, especially after the welcoming committee, aka. Fr's Wheaton Terrier, Nuella, totally jumped all over me and marked up my blacks with the dander from her fur. Seriously, though this vibrant sense of community is a gift to all who enter these doors.

There have been many highlights. Experiencing the many firsts of priestly ministry here at Holy Family: hearing confessions for the first time and actually being able to do something about it; officiating at funerals; baptizing infants during the mass; baptizing groups of infants outside of mass; witnessing back to back weddings on Saturdays during the summer; being overzealous with incense at a Thursday night Eucharistic adoration session and setting off the fire alarm!; Experiencing the Easter Triduum for the first time as a priest; washing feet; reading the part of Jesus for the Passion Narrative; processing in with the paschal candle at the Easter Vigil and nearly dropping it! Celebrating Easter Sunday morning with a massive crowd, well into the overflow.

However, it has been this past year that has been especially meaningful because I have really felt that I have gotten to know you, the parishioners, and this is why leaving is difficult. Your faith, hope, and charity has inspired me and there is something beautiful in striving for holiness together and supporting each other in that call. And this is my prayer for you, that you continue to grow and respond this call to holiness so that you may become more fully conformed to Jesus Christ and the Holy Family, in whom all find welcome and refuge.

I humbly ask for your prayers as I head out to Cudworth, Middle Lake, and St. Benedict to serve as their pastor. I am excited for the adventure and the opportunity to minister to the needs of this new flock and become a part of their community. Please know, however, that I will not forget the welcome and support you showed me and will continue to pray for you.
