



THE SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: is offered at anytime for those who are dealing with illness, imminent death, suffering or advanced age. The anointing can be arranged by calling the Parish Office and requesting a priest. For those residents at Sherbrooke Centre the Sacrament of Anointing is offered every three to four months at a regularly scheduled Mass. Please note that if the individual is in one of the city hospitals there are assigned Chaplains on duty at all time who will be able to anoint those who are hospitalized. In fairness, if death is imminent we ask that you contact the Chaplain as soon as possible to insure that the anointing can happen before death. Remember, too, that requests for a Chaplain in the middle of the night will require additional time for the Chaplain to be present. The best is to request a Chaplain during the day as often times they are already making rounds at the hospital.
