

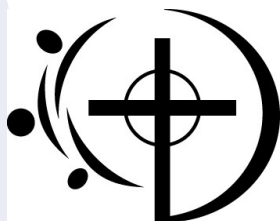

Epiphany of the Lord — January 6th, 2012

From the Pastor's Desk...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's celebration of the Feast of the Epiphany is often times called the "*Feast of Light*," or by others as the "*Feast of Coming to the Light*." Whatever name we want to give this day it is forever a day in which the Light of Christ was revealed to all the nations. The Wisemen, guided by the light of a star, came to the manger to pay their homage to the one who would give Eternal life to the peoples.

Our world today is filled with darkness. I am amazed at how many Christmas lights have already come down. Others are no longer lit in the evenings. The joy of the pre-Christmas coloured lights is now shrouded by the darkness of the day and the realization that we have months left of the winter weather. We also have spiritual darkness in our world: people searching for meaning in their lives and those who are lost in worldly pursuits. There are individuals who use the name of religion to declare war on others and use faith as an element of power rather than a vessel for service.

More than ever, our world in is need of the Coming to the Light. The beautiful words of Isaiah cry out: "*Arise and shine your light has come and the glory of the Lord is risen among you.*" This Holy Child of Bethlehem is the true light, dispelling all darkness, and drawing us into the mystery of his Father's love. This light gives meaning to our living and gives its warm glow to us as it guides us down every avenue in our lives. It is the light that walks with us, never leaving us to wallow in darkness and sin, but one that draws us ever closer to the heart of the Father.

We pray that this Epiphany Day might be one in which we too are drawn to the light. Like the sages we seek the Lord and find him in the manger and then head out into the world to share the beauty of that light.

As many of our Christian brothers and sisters prepare to celebrate the Orthodox Christmas we pray too that light will shine on all Christian people as we journey together in faith, finding common ground in the Holy Child and working together to rid us of division. May the light of the Child of Bethlehem shine upon our efforts.

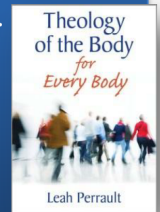
