

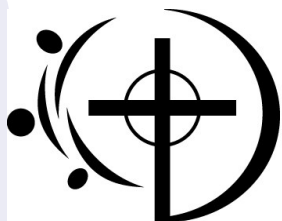

From the Pastor's Desk...

My Dear Friends,

Today the Church enters into the great Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. These days afford us the opportunity to offer prayers for the ongoing dialogue between Christian people with the eventual hope of reconciliation and a Eucharistic table that can be approached by all. It also calls each of us as disciples to work toward greater unity by availing ourselves to communication and dialogue with all our brothers and sisters who believe in Jesus Christ.

The past has not always been easy. Greater efforts in ecumenical dialogue are a relatively new thing and it was the vision and the writings of the Second Vatican Council that prompted many Christian men and women to begin the task of listening to each other. In our parish we are doubly (and greatly doubly) blessed with the presence of two incredible men who walk this very journey of listening and speaking. Fr. Bernard has been the catalyst of ecumenical dialogue in our diocese for more than 50 years. His humble nature and yet assertive voice has called all men and women to see ourselves as part of a solution: not part of a problem. Our own good Bishop, Donald Bolen, has worked years at an international level promoting harmony and communication between the Christian faithful. His membership on international committees speaks of his great conviction to one day see a reconciliation of all Christian people.

To be surrounded by these two men is a blessing. Their vision speaks to all of us. Today we may be separated from our Christian brothers and sisters but both of these men reminds us of how close we really are to one another. Let us join our prayers with theirs this week and join with them in action by working toward that elusive peace that our Lord so desired when he prayed, "Make them one Father, as we are one."

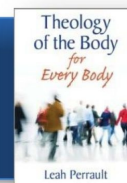
