

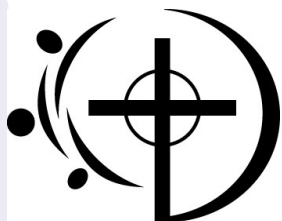

John's Gospel has a lengthy and affectionate "farewell discourse". I remember a class on John's Gospel where it was suggested that the writer himself, who was the head of an early Christian community, was elderly and about to die. The farewell seems to be even more real when we consider the sentiments behind anyone who is about to leave this world and is sharing words of wisdom they would like to leave behind.

As a parent, I often consider what it is I would like to leave as a lasting memory for my kids and grandkids. Have you ever given this some thought? What would you say to them if it was your last days? What words of remembrance would you want them to hold onto?

For me it would be: "look after each other, care for each other, make sure your brother or sister stays connected with you." If there is strong evidence that my children really love each other, I think I could die in peace.

There are similar sentiments I feel in those quiet times of prayer for the community of Holy Family. As I prepare to move on this May, I do so with a heavy heart that will miss you. Then my prayer becomes a prayer directed to Jesus: "Lord, look after these loved ones of yours. Help them to love each other and love a world so much in need of your love!"

After re-reading this, it sounds a little bit melodramatic, but this is the very message in John's Gospel for the early Christian community who have witnessed the ministry, death and resurrection of Jesus. He does not end his message with: "love me", but like a good parent, he ends with: "Love one another as I have loved you."

The "badge" of discipleship is to love one another. The model of that love is Jesus and his sacrificial gift of himself on the cross. "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." Have a great week...keep the spirit of Easter alive!

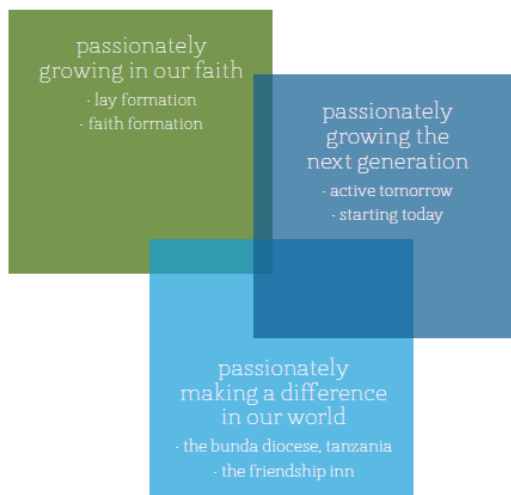

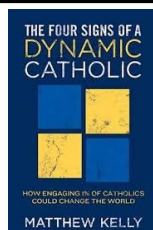
