

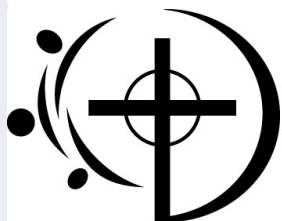

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This past week we had a special evening of song as we honoured the three years of ministry of Deacon Bob and his wife Joan. The evening was an opportunity for us to sing a few songs and have a few laughs. Along with Deacon Bob was his son Bobby, Garth Horn and myself. One of the songs we sang this past week was the Medical Mission Sisters, "Spirit of God," a most appropriate song as we prepared for the celebration of Pentecost today. The words of that song remind all of us that the Holy Spirit does what the Spirit wants to do. It is not about where I want to go, but rather, where the Spirit wants me to go. It is the Spirit that is most faithful to God and in following the Spirit we are faithful to God.

And so in letting go to that wonderful Spirit of God we let go to a faithful and wonderful friend. His faithfulness to the Spirit will be a continual blessing to the Diocese and to the Church at large.

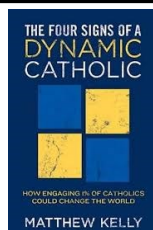
