



From the Pastor's Desk...

Even From So Little Comes So Much

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It is a very familiar reading to all of us: the feeding of the multitudes. As a young child I remember colouring pictures of the Gospel story at Catechism class. I marvelled at how Jesus had the ability to take the few fish and loaves and turn them into a feast. I wondered if it was possible that he could do the same with ice cream? Or even better, could he turn the vanilla ice cream into chocolate, because I always liked chocolate better than vanilla and my parents rarely bought chocolate ice cream.

The story has always played on my mind. Some days I could be skeptical about so little turning into so large a meal. There were days too that I wondered why Jesus felt it necessary to feed all of these people, especially when so few of them believed in him and many of them were just along for the ride hoping they would get a free meal. Then there are the other times that I just lose myself in the mystery of this wonderful Gospel lesson, reveling in the fact that God could do so much with so little.

Maybe that is the main purpose for this story: the ability of God to do so much with so little. As we recognize today's feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, we accept the mission to feed the world, both physically and spiritually. We have within us every good gift to bring the saving grace of God to the world. No one is dismissed from this reality. As disciples we are all called. We are all chosen. We are all fed.

And so we stand before the Lord with the little that we are and the little that we have. Transformed by the love of God what little we have is magnified to where it becomes the rich feast where all may eat and what little we are is transformed into something far beyond our imagining. When I give of myself for the sake of the world then God graces me to become what God desires me to be. And today, he calls us to be that broken Body and spilled Blood of his Son. Yes we are not worthy to be called to such a wondrous mission but it is so reassuring to know that even from us, lowly servants, can come so much.
