



## From the Pastor's Desk...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I had the opportunity this past week to preside at the Eucharist for the Grade 12 Retreat for our students at St. Joseph High School. For many, this might seem just another of the tasks that need to be accomplished in the month of June. As I remarked to the kids at the start of the Mass, "I know that some you may not want to be here. When I was in Grade 12 and it was June I did not want to be in a classroom."

But there was something different about this year's retreat. Some might say it all depends on the personalities of the students. Some might say it is the spirit with which they enter into moment. I looked at this group of young people, many of whom I presided at Grade 8 farewells just a few years ago, and realized what an incredibly faithful God we have.

We sat in the Chapel at St. Thomas More College, the very space I sat 30 years ago, not knowing what God wanted of me and not sure what I wanted. I had left the security and comfort of my family and my friends and community. There were so many days filled with anxiety and fear, stress, and an overwhelming sense of not knowing where I was going.

The Gospel today reminds all of us that pain and brokenness is not something that can be avoided in our lives. We will all experience those days of anxiety and fear. We will all feel the discomfort of letting go of those things that have given us stability in our lives. The good news is that Jesus reminds us that his presence, his mercy and his grace is with us. Although fear might envelop us it is the faithfulness of the Saviour that will see us through any experience. Our graduation class of 2013 will undoubtedly experience the gamut of emotions over the next few weeks. We might make it our special prayer concern to offer them to God as they prepare for their graduation and their moving onto the next part of the journey. In their faces and their lives is the faithfulness of God.

And maybe that is what was most important at that Retreat Mass: God remains faithful. I have lived the faithfulness of God - from a child to an adult. And on that beautiful June day, surrounded by the Grade 12 kids, I once again felt the heart of an 18 year old, and for that, I am ever so blessed.

**HOLY FAMILY SCHOOL UPDATE:** Construction is now well under way on Holy Family School. This two-storey school is scheduled to be completed in spring 2014, and will welcome students in September 2014. Passersby will notice changes almost daily as the school structure begins to take shape. To date, the gym walls have been completed. Installation of roof trusses over the gymnasium was continuing in May. At that time, work also began on the school's elevator shaft and the framing of several classrooms. Installation of underground services was also started. The school is located on Stensrud Road, at the north end of the site. Holy Family will adjoin a child-care centre operated by Preston Early Learning Centre, which will be situated between Holy Family and Willowgrove Public School. Plans for programming at Holy Family will begin in earnest over the next several months. Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools is aware that parents in Willowgrove are intensely interested about whether French Immersion will be offered at Holy Family or at another northeast area school (Father Robinson, Mother Teresa, St. Volodymyr). The Board can confirm that a new French Immersion program will open in the area in September 2014, with the final location to be determined this fall.
