



**THE CHRISM MASS** touches the sacramental and worship life of every church in the diocese. Because of this, every parish is invited and encouraged to be present and join in this most holy celebration. At this gathering, the priests of the diocese will renew their commitment to priestly ministry and their loyalty and obedience to their Shepherd. The Oil of the Sick (OS), Oil of the Catechumens (OC), and Sacred Chrism (SC) will be blessed by Bishop Bolen. The oils received at the Chrism Mass by parish representatives will then be taken to their respective parishes. The Chrism Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 pm, tomorrow **Monday, April 14** at the **Cathedral of the Holy Family**. An invitation is extended to all in the diocese to join with Bishop Bolen in this celebration of our unity.

OIL OF THE CATECHUMENS

**Oil of Catechumens (OC):** This oil, sometimes referred to as *Oil of Salvation*, is used to anoint the catechumens (infants and unbaptized converts to the Church) in preparation for their initiation into the Church. The prayer accompanying this anointing expresses the desire that Christ strengthen the person being anointed. This oil is also used in celebration of the baptism of children. It is a sign of belonging: marking us as members of the Body of Christ.

**Oil of the Sick (OS):** this oil is used in the Anointing of the Sick. The prayer accompanying this anointing is: *"Through this holy anointing, may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up."* This oil is used to bring comfort and support to the sick in their infirmity. The celebrating of the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is a ritual moment that makes visible and present to the sick and the whole community who we are as Church: a community of healing and support.

SACRED CHRISM

**Sacred Chrism:** to this oil is added a sweet smelling perfume or balsam. It is used at the celebration of baptism, confirmation, the ordination of priests and bishops, and for the dedication of churches and altars. It is also used in the blessing of bells and sacred vessels. Anointing with this oil implies abundance of grace and dedicated service to God. The word Christ means *"anointed one."* So being anointed with oil is a sign of the special and strengthening presence of Christ, the Anointed One.

## Stewardship Corner: Your Faith in Action
